

1st STOP CHECKLIST: APIARY (BEE KEEPING)

REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS

- [] Apiaries are regulated by the **Ohio Department of Agriculture's Division of Plant Industry**. Contact the division at **(614) 728-6373** or **(800) 282-1955**. The Ohio Department of Agriculture is also on-line at www.ohioagriculture.gov. **Remember to check local government agencies**
- [] More information about apiary regulations can be found in **Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 909**.
- [] If you will raise bees to sell, you will need a **VENDOR'S LICENSE** from **YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE**. www.business.ohio.gov **Remember to check local government agencies**
- [] If you will sell honey, please read the following:
 - **You cannot sell or label any product as pure honey if it is not pure honey.**
 - **If you are selling a blend of honey and other ingredients, the word "blend" or words stating the addition of other ingredients must be more visibly displayed than the word "honey."**
