[]	If you will sell any <b>tobacco products</b> , contact <b>YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE</b> <u>and</u> the <b>OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION</b> . * <i>Remember to check local government agencies</i> *
[]	If you will sell <b>lottery tickets</b> , contact your regional Lottery Commission Office. Information is available on-line at <a href="https://www.ohiolottery.com">www.ohiolottery.com</a> . * Remember to check local government agencies*
[]	If you will feature recorded or live <b>music</b> , you must have permission from the owner of the copyrighted material. You can do this by contacting <b>ASCAP or BMI</b> .
