

1st STOP CHECKLIST: DIETITIAN

REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS

- [] "Dietitian" means an individual licensed under **Chapter 4759** of the Ohio Revised Code to practice dietetics. <http://codes.ohio.gov>
- [] You must be licensed as a dietitian to do any the following: make nutritional assessments to determine nutritional needs and recommend appropriate nutritional intake; provide nutritional counseling or education as components of preventive, curative, and restorative health care; and develop, administer, evaluate and consult regarding nutritional care standards. ****Remember to check local government agencies****
- [] Dietitians must be licensed by the **Ohio Board of Dietetics**. Contact the board at **(614) 466-3291**. Information is also available on-line at <http://www.dietetics.ohio.gov/> ****Remember to check local government agencies****
- [] Use of the titles "Nutritionist," "Nutrition Counselor," or similar terms indicate you are practicing dietetics. If you use these titles, you must be a licensed dietitian. ****Remember to check local government agencies****
- [] If you will make retail sales (such as books or other tangible goods), you will need a **VENDOR'S LICENSE**. Contact your **COUNTY AUDITOR**. ****Remember to check local government agencies****
- [] If you have questions about sales tax, contact the **OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION** can be reached at **(888) 405-4039** or **(800) 282-1782**. Information is also on-line at www.tax.ohio.gov. ****Remember to check local government agencies****
- [] Health spas and diet centers must comply with the Prepaid Entertainment Contract Act. For more information, contact the **Ohio Attorney General's Office** at **(877) 244-6446**.
