If you will sell any tobacco products , contact YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE and the <u>OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION</u> for information.
If you will sell upholstered or stuffed items, contact the Ohio Department of Commerce's Division of Industrial Compliance, Bedding and Upholstered Furniture Section for licensing information.
