## **REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS**

IJ	Unless you are a licensed dietitian, or properly exempted by the <b>Ohio Board of Dietetics</b> , you may not: "perform nutritional assessments; recommend nutritional intake; engage in nutritional counseling; recommend or modify a medical nutrition therapy regimen; perform nutritional education; hold self out as a nutritional expert; provide professional nutrition training of other staff; [or] act in any matter related to direct nutrition care which requires judgment or decision making" (www.dietetics.ohio.gov). *Remember to check local government agencies*
[]	Use of the titles "Nutritionist," "Nutrition Counselor," or similar terms indicate you are practicing dietetics. If you use these titles, you must be a licensed dietitian.
[]	Dietitians should be careful to complete different programs each time they submit an approved program to the Board. The same program may not be submitted twice.

[]	Ohio's food labeling and retail food safety rules can be found in <b>Ohio Administrative Code (OAC)</b> 901:3 and 901:6-3-01 through 901:6-3-12 <a href="http://codes.ohio.gov">http://codes.ohio.gov</a> .
[]	Ohio's Food, Drug, Cosmetic and Device law can be found in <b>Ohio Revised Code Section 3715</b> <a href="http://codes.ohio.gov">http://codes.ohio.gov</a> .

[]	If you will make any retail sales, you must have a VENDOR'S LICENSE from YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE or the OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION can be reached at (888) 405-4039 for Business Tax Assistance; 888-405-4089 for Tax Registration; or (800) 282-1782 for the Forms Request Line.
