Checklist

- You will need a Hotel/Motel License from the State Fire Marshal's Office Bureau of Testing and Registration. Contact the bureau at (614) 752-8200. The information and forms are also on-line at <u>http://com.ohio.gov/fire/</u>. *Remember to check local government agencies*
- Information about health requirements can be found in Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3731. The ORC can be found in your local library or on-line at <u>http://codes.ohio.gov/orc/3731</u>.
- □ Information about innkeeper responsibilities can be found in ORC Section 4721 <u>http://codes.ohio.gov/orc/4721</u>
- If your establishment will have five or more rooms, you must collect sales tax on the total amount charged. You need a VENDOR'S LICENSE, please contact YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR.
 Remember to check local government agencies
- Municipalities, counties and townships may also levy an excise tax on room charges.
 Remember to check local government agencies
- □ If food will be served, you must have a **food service operation license**. Contact **your local health department** for license and inspection information.
- □ If alcoholic beverages will be served, you must have the appropriate permits. Contact the **Ohio Department of Liquor Control** at **(614) 644-2360** for more information. Information is also on-line at <u>www.com.ohio.gov/liqr</u>.
- □ If you will sell any **tobacco products**, contact **YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE** <u>and</u> the **OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION**. <u>www.business.ohio.gov</u>.
- □ If you will sell **lottery tickets**, contact your regional Lottery Commission Office. Information is available on-line at <u>www.ohiolottery.com</u>.
- You must charge sales tax on food eaten on the premises of your business, beverages, tobacco and retail sales. You will need a VENDOR'S LICENSE, please contact YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR.
