# **1<sup>st</sup> STOP CHECKLIST: INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY SALES**

Industrial supply businesses sell machinery/equipment or industrial goods to businesses that will use them in manufacturing a product.

## **REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS**

- [] There are no state level licenses required for industrial supply sales. \**Remember to check local government agencies*\*
- [] No sales tax is charged on machinery and goods used in manufacturing. \**Remember to check local government agencies*\*
- [] If your business will make retail sales (sales to an end user) you will need a vendor's license. Contact the local **COUNTY AUDITOR** or the **OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION**.
- [] The OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION can be reached at (888) 405-4039 for Business Tax Assistance; 888-405-4089 for Tax Registration; or (800) 282-1782 for the Forms Request Line. Information is also on-line at <u>http://tax.ohio.gov</u>.
- [] If your business will sell items via mail, telephone or Internet, you must comply with the **Federal Trade Commission's (FTC) Mail or Telephone Order Merchandise Trade Regulation Rule**. The Cleveland office of the FTC can be reached at (216) 263-3410. The office is also on-line at <u>www.ftc.gov</u>. \**Remember to check local government agencies*\*
- [] You must also comply with the **Ohio Telephone Solicitation Sales Act**. For more information, contact the **Ohio Attorney General** at (877)-244-0515 or (614) 466-4320. - [] Weighing and measuring devices must be inspected. Contact the Ohio Department of Agriculture, Division of Weights and Measures at (614) 728-6290 or YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR. Information is also available on-line at <u>www.agri.ohio.gov/weights</u>. \*Remember to check local government agencies\*
- [] Contact the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for information about the proper disposal of hazardous and solid waste.
