## Checklist

- In-home sales businesses must comply with the Ohio Home Solicitation Sales Act. If you have questions regarding the rules, contact the Ohio Attorney General's Office at (877)-244-0515 or (614) 466-4320. The office is also on-line at <u>http://www.ohioattorneygeneral.gov/</u>
- Information on Consumer Sales Practices can be found in the Ohio Revised Codes Section Chapter 1345. The ORC can be found in your local library or on-line at <u>http://codes.ohio.gov/orc/1345</u>.
- □ If you will sell Avon, Tupperware, etc., check with the parent company to find out if they file sales tax returns on behalf of the representative. If they do not, you must have a **VENDOR'S LICENSE**, collect sales tax, file tax returns, and keep complete records of transactions. Contact the **OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION**.
