Checklist

- Medical laboratories, including plasmapheresis centers, must register with the Ohio Department of Health. Contact the Laboratory Certification Program at (614) 644-1845 or online at www.odh.ohio.gov.
- Drug screening laboratories are regulated by the Ohio Department of Health. Contact the Alcohol/Drug Testing Approval and Permit Program at (614) 644-4609 or online at www.odh.ohio.gov.
- Contact the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for proper disposal of solid and infectious waste. General inquiries: (614) 644-3020 or (800) 329-7518. Information is available at www.epa.state.oh.us.
- If animals are brought in from out of state, contact the Ohio Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Industry at (614) 728-6220 or online at <http://www.agri.ohio.gov/animal/>.
- Ohio animal abuse laws are found in Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 959. The ORC is available online at <http://codes.ohio.gov/orc>.
