## **REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS**

A mentally ill person is defined as "one who has a substantial disorder of thought, mood, perception, orientation, or memory that grossly impairs judgement, behavior, capacity to recognize reality, or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life as defined in **Division (A) of Section 5122.01 of the Ohio Revised Code" (Ohio Revised Code Section 5122 http://codes.ohio.gov/orc)**.
