- □ Ministers cannot certify themselves with a religious society or congregation.
- Ministers must be licensed to solemnize marriages in Ohio. If you have questions or would like to request an application, contact the Ohio Secretary of State at (614) 466-3910 or toll-free at (877) 767-3453.
- The license to marry is valid only as long as you remain a minister serving and representing the religious society or congregation as it appears on the State License to Solemnize Marriages in Ohio.
