If you have a <b>storefront</b> , or <b>mobile or on-site</b> vehicle repair, you need a <b>VENDOR'S LICENSE</b> from <b>YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR</b> or information is also on-line at <a href="http://business.ohio.gov">http://business.ohio.gov</a> .
[]	If you will sell tires, contact the <b>OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION</b> for information about tire fees.
[]	If you have questions about sales tax, contact the OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION at (888) 405-4039 for Business Tax Assistance; (888) 405-4089 for Tax Registration; or (800) 282-1782 for the Forms Request Line. Information is also on-line at <a href="http://tax.ohio.gov">http://tax.ohio.gov</a> . *Remember to check local government agencies.*
[]	If you will provide motor vehicle collision repair, you must register with the <b>Ohio Board of Motor Vehicle Collision Repair</b> . Contact the board at <b>(614) 995-0714</b> . Information and registration forms are also available on-line at <a href="www.collisionboard.ohio.gov/">www.collisionboard.ohio.gov/</a> .
()	Auto repairs are also regulated by <b>Ohio's Auto Repairs and Services Law</b> . Please read the attached information from the <b>Ohio Attorney General's Office</b> .
