## 1<sup>st</sup> STOP CHECKLIST: NURSERY/GREENHOUSE

## **REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS**

**Nursery** means "any grounds or premises on or in which nursery stock is propagated or grown for sale." **Nursery stock** means "(1) any hardy [capable of surviving the normal winter temperatures of this state] tree, shrub, plant, or bulb, whether wild or cultivated, except turf grass, and any cutting, graft, scion, or bud thereof; (2) any non-hardy plant, or plant part, which is to be offered for sale in any state which requires inspection and certification of such plant or plant part as a condition of entrance therein (this includes Christmas trees)."

П Nurseries must be inspected and licensed by the Ohio Department of Agriculture, Division of Plant Health.
