## 1<sup>st</sup> STOP CHECKLIST: PERSONAL SERVICES

This checklist applies to companion services and miscellaneous personal services such as shopping, running errands, providing limited transportation, organizing photographs, etc.

## **REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS**

[]	Ohio's laws regarding homemaker service can be found in <b>Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Section 173.</b> The <b>OAC</b> can be found in your local library or on-line at <a href="http://codes.ohio.gov/oac">http://codes.ohio.gov/oac</a> . Tasks that are components of the <b>homemaker service</b> under rule <b>173-3-06.4 of the Administrative Code</b> , includes managing the household, handling personal affairs, and providing assistance with self-administration of medications.
[]	Most personal services do not require a state licensing. However, if you will provide cleaning or lawn care services, you will need a vendor's license from the Ohio Department of Taxation.
[]	Transportation of people is taxable. You must have a <b>vendor's license</b> and collect sales tax. Contact <b>your county auditor</b> or Information is also on-line at <a href="http://business.ohio.gov">http://business.ohio.gov</a> .
[]	If you have questions about vendor's licenses or sales tax, contact the <b>Ohio Department</b> of <b>Taxation</b> at <b>(888) 405-4039</b> for <b>Business Tax Assistance</b> ; <b>888-405-4089</b> for <b>Tax Registration</b> ; or <b>(800) 282-1782</b> for the <b>Forms Request Line</b> . []	If you will provide <b>transportation</b> for your customers, check with your local licensing department to find out what type of license you need.
[]	If you will work with older adults, contact the <b>Ohio Department of Aging</b> at <b>(614) 466-5500 or 1-800-266-4346</b> . Information is also on-line at <a href="http://aging.ohio.gov/goldenbuckeye/">http://aging.ohio.gov/goldenbuckeye/</a> .
