Information and registration forms can also be found online at <a href="www.puco.ohio.gov">www.puco.ohio.gov</a> . *Remember to check local government agencies.*
[]	You may need a <b>COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE</b> . Contact the <b>Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles at (614) 752-7500</b> for more information. The Bur <b>eau of Motor Vehicles</b> is online at <a href="https://www.bmv.ohio.gov">www.bmv.ohio.gov</a> .
[]	Intrastate transportation of people is taxable. You must have a VENDOR'S LICENSE and collect sales tax. Contact YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR or the OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION can be reached at (888) 405-4039 for Business Tax Assistance; 888-405-4089 for Tax Registration; or (800) 282-1782 for the Forms Request Line.
