[]	If you will sell alcohol , you must have the appropriate permit. Contact the Ohio Department of Liquor Control at (614) 644-2360 for more information. Information is also on-line at http://www.com.ohio.gov/liqr/ . *Remember to check local government agencies.*
[]	Weighing and measuring devices must be inspected. Contact YOUR COUNTY AUDITOR. *Remember to check local government agencies.*
