REQUIREMENTS & REGULATIONS

Federal Regulations

- [] The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) regulates telephone sales. You must follow the FTC's Mail or Telephone Order Merchandise Trade Regulation Rule. If you have any questions about federal regulations, please call the FTC's Cleveland Regional Office at (216) 263-3410. The FTC is also on-line at www.ftc.gov.
- [] The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) also regulates telephone solicitations (especially fax transmissions and autodialers). For more information, please contact the FCC at (888) 225-5322. The FCC is also on-line at <u>www.fcc.gov</u>.

State Regulations

- [] Like any other business, telephone merchants must comply with the Ohio Consumer's Sales Practices Act. The act prohibits unethical and devious sales practices. For full text, please read the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 1345. <u>http://codes.ohio.gov/</u>
- [] telephone businesses also must comply with the **Ohio Telephone Solicitation Sales Act**. The act can be found in the **ORC Section 4719**. <u>http://codes.ohio.gov/</u>
- [] The **ORC** can be found in your local library or on-line at <u>http://codes.ohio.gov/orc</u>.
- [] If you are making **telephone** sales, you may need a **certificate of registration** from the **Ohio Attorney General**. You may also need a surety bond.
- [] If you have questions about state laws, please contact the Ohio Attorney General's Office at (800) 282-0515 or (614) 466-4320. The office is also on-line at <u>http://www.ohioattorneygeneral.gov/</u>.
- [] Currently, there are no specific licensing requirements (other than vendor's licensing) for online auctions. **Remember to check local government agencies**
- [] Whether you are selling goods via the mail, telephone or Internet, you will need a TRANSIENT VENDOR LICENSE. Contact the OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION at (888) 405-4039 for Business Tax Assistance; 888-405-4089 for Tax Registration; or (800) 282-1782 for the Forms Request Line.
