[]	Municipalities, counties and townships may also levy an excise tax on room charges.  *Remember to check local government agencies*
[]	If food will be served, you must have a <b>food service operation license</b> . Contact <b>your local health department</b> for license and inspection information.  *Remember to check local government agencies*
[]	If alcoholic beverages will be served, you must have the appropriate permits. Contact the <b>Ohio Department of Liquor Control</b> at <b>(614) 644-2360</b> for more information.
